ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Applicants must be between the ages of 18 and 25 by June 1, 2020.
- Applicants must identify as female, trans, or non-binary
- If you are applying as a resident of the United States, you must hold proper documentation as such. If you are a student, your student visa and documentation must be valid until June 2021.
 In the event that an applicant is named a winner and does not having the proper documentation, they will forfeit their award.

Exceptions are considered on a case by case basis. Eligibility questions can be addressed to elisehallsaxophonecompetition@gmail.com

2019 APPLICATION GUIDELINES

The application fee, which is used solely as a consortium fee, is \$35 USD. This payment must be paid to paypal.me/elisehallcompetition before the application will be accepted for review. Payments will not be accepted until May 1st, 2020.

Repertoire requirements are as follows:

- Florent Schmitt, Légende, Op. 66
 - o piano accompaniment required
- Solo work of your choice
 - Must be written by a composer who identifies as female, trans, or non-binary, AND/OR written by a composer in either the <u>Institute for Composer Diversity Database</u> or the database included on our website.
 - There is no time limit for the piece of choice but judges are not obligated to listen to the entirety of the 'choice' video.
 - o piano or electronic accompaniment required when applicable

Video Submission Requirements are as follows:

Video submission only. Audio files will not be judged.

- Each video should be submitted as a YouTube link and clearly labelled with the title of the work, the composer, and the performer name
- Each recording must start at the beginning of the movement; excerpts will not be judged
- Only single camera video should be submitted
- Both performers must be visible, when applicable
- Edited videos will not be judged
- Recordings of poor quality will not be judged.

SUBMISSION OF MATERIALS

Applications must be submitted as a sharable Google Drive folder titled as your name to elisehallsaxophonecompetition@gmail.com. The folder should contain the following:

- PDF Application form titled 'your name, application' can be found at the end of this document
- Google Document titled 'your name, recordings'
 - Videos should be listed as YouTube links, with the title and composer of each work
- PDF Score of work of your choice titled 'your name, piece of choice'
- One high resolution headshot titled 'your name, headshot'
- Google Document titled 'your name, biography' with a biography that does not exceed 1000 characters

Sharing permissions for your Google Drive Folder must be set to allow access to the folder and to each item within in the folder.

All materials must be submitted through email on or before **June 1st, 2020 at 11:59 pm PST** and winners will be announced through email around **July 1st, 2020**.

In the case that the American winner cannot travel in Fall of 2020, the second-place American winner will serve as an alternate.
